#### **Security of Clubhouse precinct**

There was a security breach of the Clubhouse precinct recently. The Clubhouse security was not penetrated, but parties external to the membership of the Club entered the Club car park via an insecure part of the external boundary fence line. The parties that entered were challenged by a member of the Club who was in attendance at the time and the intruders departed.

The intrusion has been reported to Parks Victoria, who are responsible for the fence line and they have committed to remediation of the area in order to improve the exterior boundary of the Club car park.

The Club Committee will conduct a fuller review of the local area security issues and address further improvements as necessary.
